Amazing Futures Data Sharing and Consent Form



Amazing Futures activities are funded from a range of sources. This includes Sussex Learning Network – SLN. As part of funding agreements with SLN, Amaze needs to share information about young people participating in Amazing Futures with SLN.

This is the information we will share about you:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Postcode
- Gender
- Dates and locations of the workshops/Amazing Futures sessions you attended
- Your primary additional need

What happens to this information?

- With your consent, Amaze will pass this information securely to SLN.
- SLN then stores this information on their own databases. For SLN this includes two third-party databases they have data sharing agreements with, The Higher Education Access Tracker (HEAT) and The Higher Education Statistical Agency (HESA). This is so that they can see if any young people from the workshops go on to make an application to go to university in the future.

- Information will not be used by SLN for any other purpose.
- Any young person can ask for their information to be deleted by SLN at any stage (now or in the future). See [SLN's privacy statement](#) for more information.

Consent Form



Amaze sometimes has someone **take photos or video** at groups and events. We also sometimes meet up with a young person or family that uses Amaze services to take photos or video of them.

Some of the ways we use these photos and videos are:

- to show people **what Amaze does**, and what to expect at our events and groups
- to **illustrate articles** about Amaze or disability issues
- to **celebrate the successes** of our young people and families
- as part of our **videos** telling people about Amaze or disability issues
- on our **leaflets, flyers, and posters**
- in our **e-newsletter** and young people's magazine
- in our **fundraising** campaigns

These photos and videos may be **shared on the internet**, on our website, Facebook, Youtube channel, e-newsletter, etc.

The photos may also be **used in print**, for example leaflets and posters. Sometimes local newspapers write stories about Amaze, and we share photos with them to use with the story.

Sometimes we play videos we've made **at Amaze events**, for example at a local cinema.

The photographer may ask to use some of the photos in their **portfolio**. A portfolio is a website showing a selection of their photos.

Further information

- This consent form is for photographs/videos taken by Amaze, or on Amaze's behalf, **for Amaze to use** in the ways you have agreed to.
- Sometimes Amaze will make an agreement with a photographer for them to take photos for Amaze. If this happens then **the photographer owns the copyright** on the photos they take, unless they have agreed otherwise in writing.
- However, the photos **may only be used by Amaze**, or in the photographer's portfolio if you have agreed to this. Amaze will only use the photos in the ways that you have agreed to.
- We will keep this information **confidential**, which means we won't share it with other people without your permission.
- We will use this information if we need to **contact you** about photos or video we have taken of you.
- **After three years**, if we want to take more photos or video of you, we will ask you to fill out a new form.
- We will follow the rules in the **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** about handling people's information.
